Team Members: Those who are interested in being part of a medical mission team must complete an application (available in the Parish Office or at <http://www.holyfamilystow.org/honduras.php>). Team members must have a missionary spirit, an openness to serving others, be in good health, have a current passport, immunizations to travel to Honduras and pay their own way (airfare, lodging, meals, transportation, etc. will cost approximately \$1,400 per person). All applications must be submitted by October 1, 2010.

Pre-trip Pharmacy Teams: There will be a need for small groups of people of all ages to assist in preparing medicine and vitamins for travel to Honduras. These teams will be organized sometime in the Fall of 2010.

Financial Donors: There is a need to purchase medicines, vitamins, medical supplies and other items in bulk to alleviate unnecessary sorting and multiple brands and dosages. **To purchase these needed items, we will be asking for donations of \$35 or more toward the Honduras medical mission supplies with a donation envelope in the September, 2010 packet of envelopes. A check can be made payable to 'Holy Family Church' for any amount, write 'Honduras' on the memo line or on the envelope and place it in the collection basket or drop it off at the Holy Family Parish Office at 3450 Sycamore Drive, Stow OH 44224.**

Many other ways: There will be many opportunities for everyone to participate including students, scout troops, prayer groups, families, etc. to participate in this mission work.
