How do I become a Lead Crew member for 2009-2010?

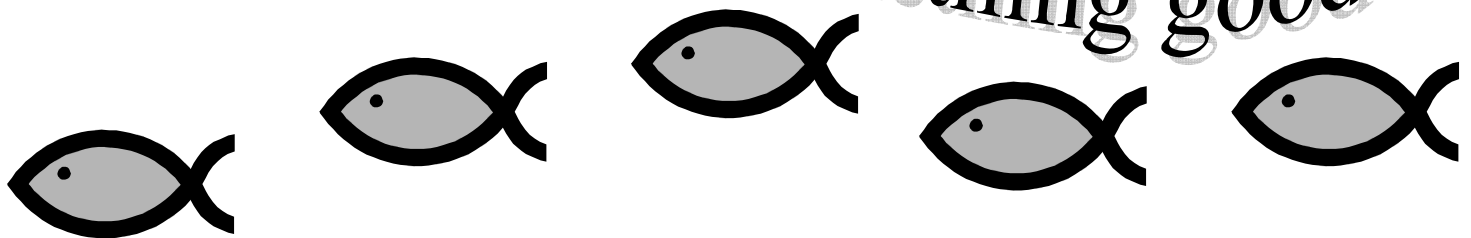
