

About the Program

Holy Family Parish offers a before and after school program for registered students at Holy Family School. This program was created to give parents an alternative for before and/or after school care for their children.

The site for the Extended Hours Program is located in the Father Szabo Parish Center. It is familiar and comfortable for the children and spacious enough to allow freedom for the children to move about. The fold-out wall tables are utilized to organize activities, provide homework space and serve as a table for snack.

The morning program is designed to give students quiet time before school. This feature is great for parents who need to get off to work earlier than 8:00 AM in the morning. Students generally read books, play cards, construct puzzles or color. This is a wonderful opportunity for them to ease into their day. A small snack will be served.

The afternoon program is structured to give students the opportunity to complete their homework and enjoy some play time. A nutritious snack is served, and the weather permitting, the children will spend some time outside with playground activities.

What is the daily schedule?

The State of Ohio requires a ratio of 1 staff member to 18 school-aged children. The staffing at the Extended Hours Program will be no less than 1 staff member to 12-15 children, depending upon the ages of the children present. For the safety of the children, there will be no fewer than two supervisory staff members present at all times.

Morning Routine

The facility opens at 7:00 AM. Parents may bring their children to the Father Szabo Parish Center and sign the child in anytime after 7:00 AM. A small snack will be served at 8:00 AM. IF you would like to provide a snack for your child, you may have your child bring it to eat at that time. Quiet activities are available for children to do, such as construct a puzzle, color, draw, play cards or board games, read a book, talk with a friend, etc.

Afternoon Routine

3:20 Arrive at FSPC
3:20-3:30 Bathroom break; change if desired
3:30-3:45 Snack
3:45-4:15 Outdoor or indoor play
4:15-4:45 Homework time (if parent elects)
4:45-5:15 Continued homework if necessary or organized activity/quiet play
5:15-6:00 Organized activities/play time
6:00 Extended Hours Concludes



How do I enroll by child?

The criteria needed for enrollment into the Holy Family Extended Hours Program is as follows:

- ☞ Child must be school-aged, registered student at Holy Family School *and*
- ☞ Registration Form must be completed *and*
- ☞ Weekly Attendance Form must be completed *and*
- ☞ Emergency Medical Authorization Form must be completed *and*
- ☞ Pick-up Authorization Form must be completed *and*
- ☞ Remittance of a non-refundable, registration fee.
